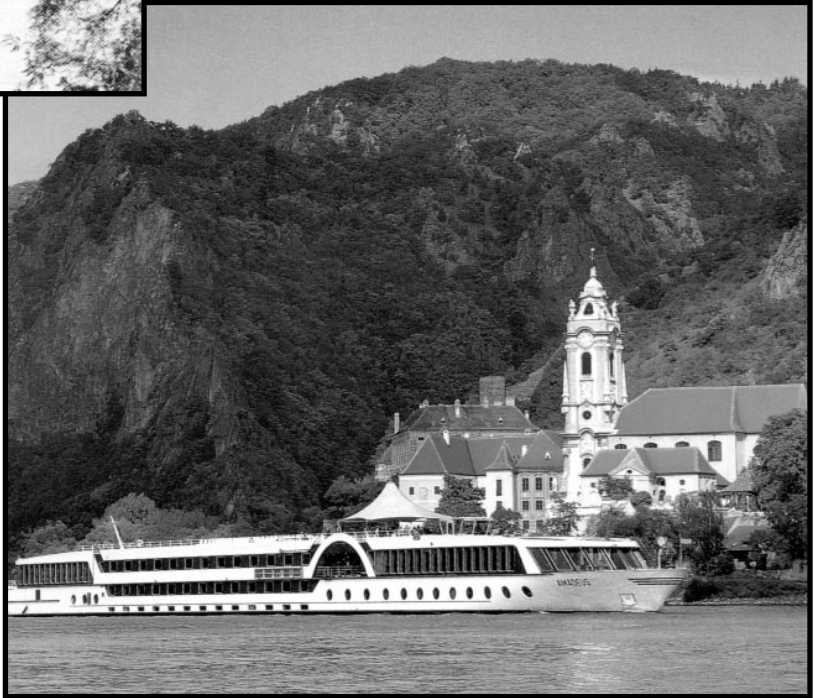
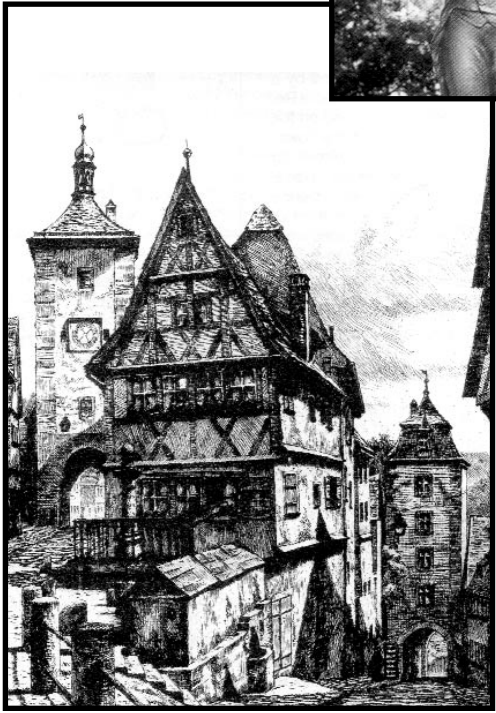

BUDAPEST – DANUBE CRUISE (Esztergom – Bratislava – Vienna – Wachau – Melk – Linz – Passau) – NUREMBERG – PRAGUE – DRESDEN – BERLIN

Day 01,

Sep 21, Wed: CANADA – BUDAPEST

Departure for Europe

Day 02,

Sep 22, Thu: ARRIVE BUDAPEST

Arrival and transfer to hotel for check in and dinner (D)

Day 03,

Sep 23, Fri: BUDAPEST – EMBARK DANUBE CRUISE

We start with a City Tour with the major sites like the Fishermen's Bastion and St. Stephens Cathedral – then we head to Szentendre, the charming little village north of Budapest – local artisans and typical restaurants line the main square – return to Budapest and embark on the MS AMADEUS CLASSIC – after welcome drinks – dinner – departure upstream later in the evening (B)

Day 04,

Sep 24, Sat: ESZTERGOM – BRATISLAVA

Today we arrive in Esztergom there we tour the Cathedral which is a small scale replica of St. Peter's in Rome, most Hungarian Kings were crowned here and Cardinal Mindzenty worked here – we then continue on to Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia – after a tour of the town we have return aboard ship for dinner

Day 05,

Sep 25, Sun: VIENNA – WACHAU VALLEY

All day in Vienna – with a city tour including the famous sites like the Ringstrasse with its royal buildings, Hundertwasserhaus – and afternoon either at leisure in the city or visit to Schoenbrunn Palace – return to the ship and departure upstream

Day 06,

Sep 26, Mon: WACHAU – MELK – LINZ

Morning arrival in the Wachau Valley, famous for its vineyards and castles – upon arrival in Melk tour of Austria's most famous Benedictine monastery with its art treasures and unique library – continue upstream later this afternoon – farewell dinner this evening

Day 07,

Sep 27, Tue: PASSAU – NUREMBERG

This morning we leave the ship and visit Passau and enjoy an organ concert in the wonderful cathedral – then we travel via Regensburg, famous for its Roman past, on to Nuremberg for overnight and dinner (D)

Day 08,

Sep 28, Wed: NUREMBERG - WUERZBURG – ROTHENBURG – NUREMBERG

Travel to Wuerzburg and City Tour with the beautiful Bishop's residence – then we drive to Germany's best preserved medieval city : Rothenburg – we have time for lunch there and a brief city tour, exploring the historic buildings within the walled city – in the later afternoon we return to Nuremberg in time for dinner (B,D)

Day 09,

Sep 29, Thu: NUREMBERG – PRAGUE

Morning visit of Nuremberg with a walk through the city and then departure for the Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic – check in and dinner (B,D)

Day 10,

Sep 30, Fri: PRAGUE

City Tour of Prague, the "Golden City" including the castle and the historic Inner City with St. Vitus Cathedral and Wenceslas Square – this afternoon you have a bit of time to explore on your own or do some shopping for the famous Czech Crystal before dinner (B,D)



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Day 11,

Oct 01, Sat: PRAGUE – DRESDEN – BERLIN

Today we visit Dresden, the capital of Saxony; we see the Zwinger Palace and the Semper Opera house before traveling on to Berlin (B,D)

Day 12,

Oct 02, Sun: BERLIN

City Tour with all the main sites from Brandenburg Gate to Reichstag and Checkpoint Charlie etc – enjoy the afternoon in this cosmopolitan city, stroll down the Kurfuerstendamm and do your last shopping before dinner (B,D)

Day 13,

Oct 03, Mon: BERLIN – CANADA

Transfer to the airport for the flight home (B)

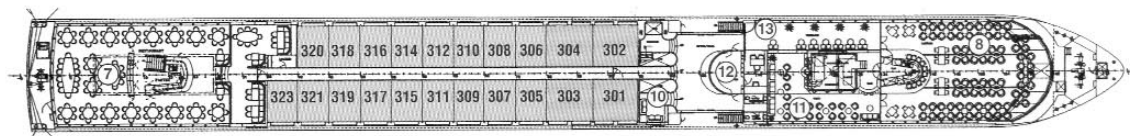

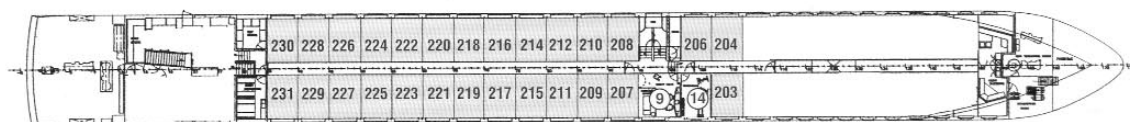
SUN-DECK



MOZART-DECK

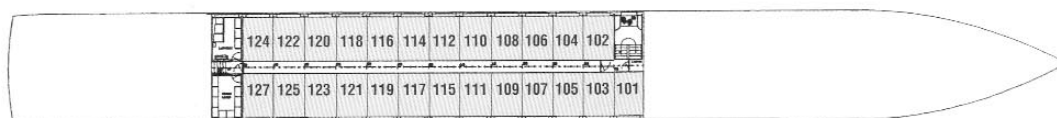


STRAUSS-DECK

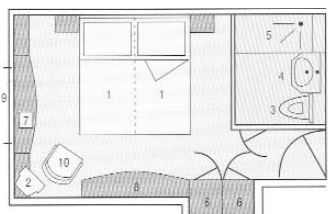

CABIN CATEGORIES:

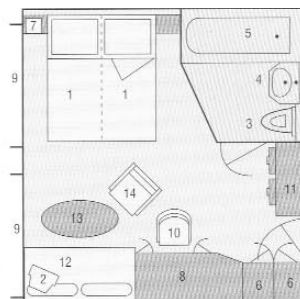
The 69 passenger cabins and 4 suites are on the outside and spread over 3 decks (named after Mozart, Strauss and Haydn) and are very generously planned (cabins 15 m² and suites 22m²). The tastefully furnished cabins are equipped with shower, WC, air-conditioning, direct-dial telephone and colour TV with an information and video channel in addition to satellite programmes. There is the option of having the two beds spaced apart. The size and furnishings of the cabins are identical on all three decks. The cabins on the Mozart and Strauss deck have a large panorama window (cabins 203-206 have round windows), while the windows on the Haydn deck are somewhat smaller. E-mail service available on board.
