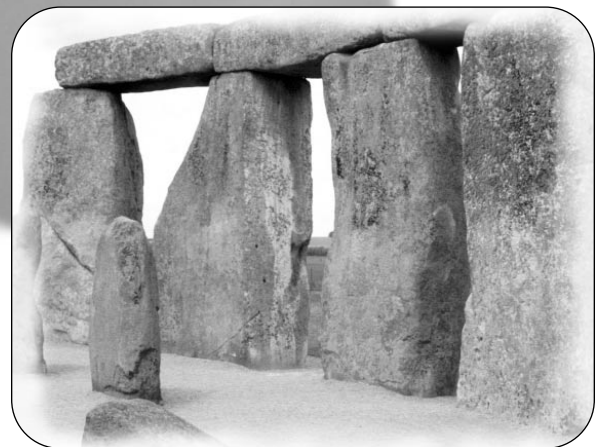
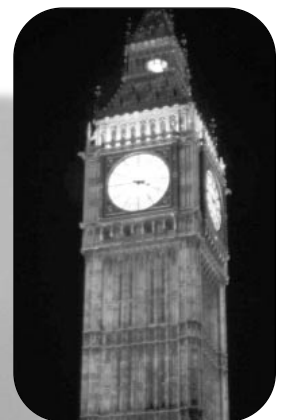


# AIR FORCE TOUR OF GREAT BRITAIN

**Day 01,**

**Sep 25, Tue: CANADA – GLASGOW**

Departure from Canada for Europe

**Day 02,**

**Sep 26, Wed: ARRIVAL GLASGOW**

After arrival in Glasgow transfer to hotel and at leisure before dinner

**Day 03,**

**Sep 27, Thu: GLASGOW – LOCH LOMOND – EDINBURGH**

On our morning orientation of Scotland's largest city we see the 12th century cathedral and the elegant Georgian squares, built by the wealthy tobacco barons – we then take off towards the north and stop at Loch Lomond before we travel on to Edinburgh

**Day 04,**

**Sep 28, Fri: EDINBURGH**

A City tour introduces us to the historic city as we visit also Edinburgh Castle .. then there is time to enjoy lunch on your own before we head to East Fortune and visit the Museum of Flight ... return to Edinburgh in time for dinner

**Day 05,**

**Sep 29, Sat: EDINBURGH – SUNDERLAND – THIRSK – YORK**

Past Jedburgh and with a stop at the famous Hadrian's Wall we travel south and visit the North East Aircraft Museum at Sunderland – then we stop at Thirsk, home of James Herriot – before ending the day in York – maybe enjoy a walk around town and check out one of the inviting Pubs

**Day 06,**

**Sep 30, Sun: YORK**

A morning city tour will get us acquainted with the beautiful city, the York Minster, the walls and the maze of streets (Shambles) ... in the afternoon we will enjoy a brief drive to Selby for a visit to the Real Aeroplane Museum and return back to home base afterwards

**Day 07,**

**Oct 01, Mon: YORK**

Today we will visit the Yorkshire Air Museum & Allied Air Forces Memorial which is located on a WWII Bomber Command airfield outside of town; it is one of the best of its kind with a Canadian Memorial Hangar which houses a Halifax and Mosquito Bomber amongst others – the afternoon is yours to enjoy: maybe visit the National Railway Museum, or take a short river boat cruise

**Day 08,**

**Oct 02, Tue: YORK – NEWARK – CAMBRIDGE**

Traveling south we stop in Lincoln (one of England's finest historic towns) with its great cathedral – then we continue to Newark and visit the Newark Air Museum on the old Bomber Command Winthorpe airfield – and then continue on to Cambridge

**Day 09,**

**Oct 03, Wed: CAMBRIDGE**

The university town is dominated by its 31! colleges, some of which boast incredible traditions and on our tour we will get acquainted with some of the history – then we explore the Shuttleworth Collection at Biggleswade (Bedfordshire) before returning back to Cambridge

**Day 10,**

**Oct 04, Thu: CAMBRIDGE**

On today's agenda we have the magnificent Imperial War Museum at Duxford – the jewel of aviation museums in the UK - just south of the city and after spending plenty of time exploring the vast array of aircraft (there are about 170 on display!) – we return later in the afternoon and you have time to enjoy the city

**Day 11,**

**Oct 05, Fri: CAMBRIDGE – LONDON**

Before arriving in the capital we stop by the RAF Museum at Hendon, the main museum of its kind with a Battle of Britain hangar and numerous exhibits from WWI and WWII – arrival in London in the late afternoon

**Day 12,**

**Oct 06, Sat: LONDON**

Today we have a morning tour of the main sights of London and then we visit the Imperial War Museum, with its special exhibits on aviation, WWI and WWII, etc – spend as much as time as you like or take some time for shopping (Harrod's) or visit the Science Museum or any of the other famous spots (British Museum, Madame Tussauds, etc) – in the evening you might want to take in a



show in one of the many theatres or simply enjoy a Pub dinner (today is the only evening on which dinner is not included so you can venture out on your own)

**Day 13,**

**Oct 07, Sun: LONDON – CANADA**

Transfer to the airport for the flight home

**Day 13,**

**Oct 07, Sun: LONDON – WINCHESTER – SALISBURY**

After leaving the capital we stop at Runnymede RAF Memorial with more than 20,000 names engraved on the pillars of the Memorial and we also visit Brookwood Military Cemetery (with graves from the RCAF and the Dieppe Raid amongst others) – then we stop in historic Winchester and we end the day in scenic Salisbury, our home base for the next days

**Day 14,**

**Oct 08, Mon: SALISBURY**

On our agenda today we have the Bournemouth Aviation Museum and in the afternoon we visit the the Museum of Army Flying in Middle Wallop – the later part of the afternoon is yours to enjoy Salisbury (we will of course include a visit to Salisbury Cathedral)

**Day 15,**

**Oct 09, Tue: SALISBURY**

After stopping at Stonehenge we travel west to Yeovilton where we visit the Fleet Air Arm Museum (with a great selection of exhibits from WWI through to Korea and the Falklands) – we then return back to Salisbury

**Day 16,**

**Oct 10, Wed: SALISBURY – SOUTHAMPTON – LONDON**

It is off to the Southampton Hall of Aviation and after time for lunch in Portsmouth we travel on and visit briefly the Tangmere Military Aviation Museum and if time allows we will pass Goodwood Airfield (which was used extensively by Canadian fighter Squadrons) and head back towards the capital, checking into our hotel near Heathrow Airport

**Day 17,**

**Oct 11, Thu: LONDON – CANADA**

Depending on the flight schedule there might be time to head into the city by underground for some last minute shopping – then we transfer to the airport for the flight home

- Breakfast and dinner every day (1 dinner in London not included)

## FACTS YOU SHOULD KNOW!

### RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT:

A deposit of \$400 per person is required at the time of making a reservation on the Special Travel International (hereafter called STI) tour of your choice. This deposit forms part of your final payment which is due 2 months prior to departure. Travel documents will be sent to you approximately 14 days prior to your trip departure, provided full payment has been received.

### TOUR PRICES:

All tour prices for land arrangements are based on rates effective at the time of printing and are expected to be in effect at the time of departure. Should these rates change, it may be necessary to surcharge the price of your vacation. Should the tour price increase by more than 10%, the passenger shall have the right to cancel within seven days of notification without penalty.

### CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS:

Notice of cancellation must be made in writing. The effective cancellation date is the date when written notification is received by STI. The deposit is non refundable.

The following scale of charges will apply when cancellation is received within 60 days of departure.

God, strikes, weather, quarantine, accidents, sickness, government regulations, insufficient documents and any loss expense resulting from the above contingencies shall be borne by the tour member. In the event it becomes necessary or advisable for the comfort of the passenger, or for any reason whatsoever, to alter the itinerary or arrangements, such alterations may be made without penalty to the operators. Additional expense, if any, shall be borne by the passenger. The right is reserved to withdraw any or all tours should conditions warrant, and also to decline to accept or retain any passenger as a member of the tour. In such instances, full or equitable amounts will be refunded.
