May 01 - 09, 2005 (9 days) - Tour # 2

Day 01,

May 01, Sun: CANADA – AMSTERDAM
Departure from Canada for Amsterdam

Day 02,

May 02, Mon: ARRIVE AMSTERDAM – CENTRAL HOLLAND
After arrival we take the short drive to the city centre for an orientation tour – then we travel to Central Holland where we check into our hotel and there is a bit of time to relax before dinner

Day 03,

May 03, Tue: CENTRAL HOLLAND – GROESBEEK – NIJMEGEN – CENTRAL HOLLAND
On today's agenda is the official Remembrance ceremony at **Groesbeek Cemetery** – afterwards we head to **Nijmegen** and see the famous **John Frost Bridge** (made famous through the movie "A Bridge Too Far") and also visit the nearby **Airborne Museum of Oosterbeek** dedicated to the operation "Market Garden" – we head back to home base in time for dinner



Day 04,

May 04, Wed: CENTRAL HOLLAND – BERGEN OP ZOOM – KEUKENHOF – CENTRAL HOLLAND
Traveling south we visit **Bergen op Zoom Canadian Cemetery** – then we take a drive through the fascinating **Scheldt** area, the areas which were partly flooded during the war – we head north, passing **The Hague** en route to the wonderful flower gardens of **Keukenhof** – enjoy the tulip fields in bloom that time of year before we return to our hotel

Day 05,

May 05, Thu: CENTRAL HOLLAND – KATWIJK – CENTRAL HOLLAND
We participate at the parade and ceremonies of **Katwijk**, a charming town along the coast, during which the town commemorates the freedom it regained 60 years ago with the help of Canadian soldiers – enjoy meeting the locals during the special festivities

Day 06,

May 06, Fri: CENTRAL HOLLAND – GERMANY - RHINE BOAT TRIP – CENTRAL HOLLAND
This morning we drive to Germany and visit the **Hochwald / Kleve area** and will also visit Reichswald Forest Cemetery (the largest WWII Commonwealth cemetery – 708 of whom are Canadian airmen) – then you can enjoy the scenery and sit back during our **boat trip on the Rhine River** on our way back to Holland – then we return to our hotel for dinner



Day 07,

May 07, Sat: CENTRAL HOLLAND – HOLTEN – GRONINGEN – CENTRAL HOLLAND

Today's excursion brings us to the **Canadian Cemetery** at **Holten** where we participate at the Remembrance ceremony before we drive to Northern Holland – we stop in **Groningen** where there is time for lunch and to enjoy the town – then we continue our drive to the coastal batteries at **Termunten and Delfzijl** before returning to home base in time for dinner

FACTS YOU SHOULD KNOW!

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT:

A deposit of \$300 per person is required at the time of making a reservation on the Special Travel International (hereafter called STI) tour of your choice. This deposit forms part of your final payment which is due eight weeks prior to departure. Travel documents will be sent to you approximately 14 days prior to your trip departure, provided full payment has been received.

TOUR PRICES:

All tour prices for land arrangements are based on rates effective at the time of printing and are expected to be in effect at the time of departure. Should these rates change, it may be necessary to surcharge the price of your vacation. Should the tour price increase by more than 10%, the passenger shall have the right to cancel within seven days of notification without penalty.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS:

Notice of cancellation must be made in writing. The effective cancellation date is the date when written notification is received by STI. The deposit is non refundable.

The following scale of charges will apply when cancellation is received within 60 days of departure.

60-30 days prior to departure	50%
29-15 days prior to departure	75%
14-0 days prior to departure	100%

RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY:

STI acts only as an agent in securing all services related to the tours described in this brochure, including transportation, sightseeing and accommodation. STI shall not be responsible or liable for any loss, cost, damage, injury, delay or expense arising from the use of any conveyance, accommodation or service or from acts of God, strikes, weather, quarantine, accidents, sickness, government regulations, insufficient documents and any loss expense resulting from the above contingencies shall be borne by the tour member. In the event it becomes necessary or

advisable for the comfort of the passenger, or for any reason whatsoever, to alter the itinerary or arrangements, such alterations may be made without penalty to the operators.

Additional expense, if any, shall be borne by the passenger. The right is reserved to withdraw any or all tours should conditions warrant, and also to decline to accept or retain any passenger as a member of the tour. In such instances, full or equitable amounts will be refunded.

INSURANCE:

STI recommends that each tour participant has health, cancellation, interruption, accident and baggage insurance for the duration of his/her travel, (in case of insurance not being included in the tour price).

TRAVEL DOCUMENT:

It is entirely the passenger's responsibility to possess whatever documents and VISAS are required by the law of the countries visited on the tour.

AIRLINE RESPONSIBILITY:

Any airliner carrier providing transportation in connection with these tours is not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time the passenger is not on board its planes or conveyances. The passenger contract in use by the airlines concerned, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the airline and the purchase of these tours and/or passenger. Similar responsibility as noted applies to all types of carriers, including car rental companies.
