

HOCKEY TOURNAMENT IN ST.PETERSBURG, RUSSIA 2 & HOCKEY WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP IN MOSCOW, RUSSIA April 21 - May 01, 2007



St.Petersburg - Peter the Great wanted the city to rival Venice – and with its 101 islands, 66 canals and hundreds of bridges the city is without a doubt the country’s most beautiful

Moscow - It boasts modern boulevards and parks, but is also the guardian of over 800 monuments of Russian history and World culture – from the Red Square to Moscow University and the Bolshoi Theater and St.Basil’s Cathedral with its multi-colored onion domes, from the Lenin Mausoleum to the WWII Memorial

April 21, Sat: **CANADA – ST.PETERSBURG**
Departure for Europe

After arrival in the afternoon transfer to hotel and at leisure before dinner (D)

April 26, Thu: **ST.PETERSBURG – MOSCOW**
Today we leave by train for Moscow – upon arrival transfer to hotel and dinner (B,D)
- Day 07,**
April 27, Fri: **MOSCOW**
Today Half day Panoramic City Tour with many of the famous sites – afternoon at leisure and then evening game **CANADA : XXX** (B)
- Day 08,**
April 28, Sat: **MOSCOW**
Half day city Tour with Kremlin (incl Cathedrals and Armory) – afternoon and evening at leisure (B,D)
- Day 09,**
April 29, Sun: **MOSCOW**
At leisure (or optional tour outside the city to the famous palace of Catherine the Great) – evening game **CANADA : XXX** (B)
- Day 10,**
April 30, Mon: **MOSCOW**
Today we play a leisure game – and then evening special folklore farewell dinner (B,D)
- Day 11,**
May 01, Tue: **MOSCOW – CANADA**
Transfer to the airport for flight home (B)
